### C. Athlete Eligibility

ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY
All athletes must comply with the provisions of the Olympic Charter currently in force and only those athletes who have complied with the Olympic Charter may participate in the Olympic Games.

### D. Qualification System

QUALIFICATION PATHWAY
<p>The quota place is allocated to the athlete by name. National Olympic Committees (NOCs) with more than two (2) qualified athletes have the authority to decide which two (2) athletes they will enter.</p> <p>Athletes must have achieved their qualification position:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Through an official Olympic qualification competition</li> <li>▪ Through the Pentathlon World Ranking</li> <li>▪ By the Tripartite Commission Invitation places</li> <li>▪ Or, by the host nation provisions.</li> </ul>

The 33 quota places per gender will be allocated as follows:

<p><b>1 Place</b></p>	<p><b>2011 UIPM World Cup Final</b> One (1) quota place will be allocated to the winner of the Final</p>										
<p><b>3 Places</b></p>	<p><b>2011 World Championship</b> Quota places will be allocated to the three (3) best ranked athletes. If the winner of the World Cup Final achieves one of these places, the 4<sup>th</sup> highest placed athlete will obtain a quota place.</p>

<p><b>7 Places</b></p>	<p><b>Pentathlon World Ranking</b> Seven (7) quota places will be allocated to the next best seven (7) best ranked athletes according to the World Ranking as of 1 June 2012, who have not yet qualified.  If an athlete achieves a qualification place at the 2011 World Cup Final, the 2011 World Championships, the 2012 UIPM World Championships or via the Pentathlon World Ranking List (as of 1 June 2012) and has already qualified, his/her place will be reallocated to the next best ranked athletes and thereafter according to the Pentathlon World Ranking List (as of 1 June 2012).</p>										

**HOST COUNTRY REPRESENTATION**

The host nation will be guaranteed one (1) quota place per gender, if not otherwise qualified.

**TRIPARTITE COMMISSION PLACES**

Four (4) Tripartite Commission Invitation Places are made available for eligible NOCs.

On 1 November 2011, the International Olympic Committee will contact all those NOCs who are eligible to apply for Tripartite Commission Invitation Places.

The deadline for NOCs to submit their requests for Tripartite Commission Invitation Places is 16 January 2012. In relation to the end of the qualification period, the Tripartite Commission will confirm, in writing, the allocation of invitation places to the respective NOCs between 1 May and 9 July 2012.

Detailed information on Tripartite Invitation places is contained in the – Tripartite Commission Invitation Places - Information Paper for NOCs – which is included in the Games of the XXX Olympiad, London 2012 Qualification and Participation Criteria.

**E. Confirmation process for quota places**

**CONFIRMATION PROCESS FOR QUOTA PLACES**

By 1 June 2012, the UIPM will confirm in writing to all NOCs the number of qualification places they have achieved. NOCs will have to confirm in writing by 15 June 2012 to the UIPM the use of their quota places.

By 30 June 2012 the UIPM will confirm in writing the reallocation of all unused quota places according to the procedure described below in Section F.

**F. Reallocation of unused quota places**

**REALLOCATION OF UNUSED IF QUOTA PLACES**

**Continental championships**

Quota places allocated through continental championships which are not used by the respective NOC will be reallocated to the next best ranked athlete/NOC at the respective continental championship, not yet qualified.

**Other places**

All other unused quota place(s) will be reallocated to NOCs of the next best ranked athletes on the UIPM World Ranking list of 1 June 2012, not yet qualified.

**REALLOCATION OF UNUSED HOST COUNTRY PLACES**

Unused Host Country quota places will be reallocated to the next best ranked athlete/NOC on the UIPM World Ranking List of 1 June 2012, not yet qualified.

**REALLOCATION OF UNUSED TRIPARTITE COMMISSION PLACES**

Any unused places within the reserved quota of places will be reallocated by the Tripartite Commission. If this is not possible, the place(s) will be reallocated to the next best ranked athlete/NOC according to the UIPM World Ranking List (as of 1 June 2012), not yet qualified.
